“Experiencing God”

“Experiencing God”, a Bible study by Henry Blackaby and Claude King will be the focus for next fall’s WOW (Worship on Wednesday) program. The studies are designed for small groups. The youth class will do the study and we are planning for two adult groups. After previewing the workbooks for a couple of weeks, watching an introductory video during a called session meeting and much prayer, the elders voted unanimously to use “Experiencing God” as a course of study. Everyone in the church is invited to participate in the Bible study which will take place each Wednesday after the meal. The Bible study will also be offered on Sunday mornings as a class. If you miss a WOW session, you can attend the Sunday morning session or vice-versa. Workbooks for the Bible study are \$14.95.
