#### **WOW - Worship on Wednesday**

WOW has gotten off to a great start. We had a wonderful catfish dinner, catered by Bill Holmes (Mary Ann Janner's brother). The Touch the Future Discernment Meeting showed the congregation the direction for the future of going back to basics--making prayer, studying the word of God and discipleship (evangelism) a priority in our lives and in our church.
