General Assembly - Celebrating 200th Anniversary

The 180th General Assembly of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church will meet in Dickson, TN to celebrate the 200th Anniversary of the founding of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church on June 13-18, 2010. Mark your calendars. Cumberland Presbyterian Women's Ministry Convention will be June 16-17 at Montgomery Bell State Park.

DAY TRIP - June 15 - 200th Birthday of the Church

The All Day Celebration at the Birthplace Shrine will be **Tuesday, June 15**. SCHEDULE: 10 am-Celebration worship and communion service, Dr. Jay Earhart-Brown, preacher. 11:30 am: Lunch on the grounds (you MUST order and prepay \$10 each for the lunches by May 30); 12:30 - 3 pm: More activities than you can see!

In the chapel, every 20 minutes, a different speaker representing the CPCA, Choctaw, Andes, Korean, showing the diversity of our denomination. In the McAdow cabin: in the kitchen, Mrs. McAdow and her daughter (Amanda Boaz) will be sharing information about food preservation and preparation in 1810; in the bedroom Mrs. King will be quilting

On the grounds around the cabin: 4 different areas where musicians will be performing various types of music of 1810 & gospel; 2 areas of children's games of the early 1800's; approximately 10 different crafters, demonstrating crafts of the era; "founding fathers" McAdow, Ewing, King, and McLean will be strolling the grounds answering questions and sharing of their life. Across the bridge from the cabin will be a site set aside for meditation, reminisce of McAdow spending the night in prayer out from the house - persons will be encouraged to thank God for our past, His presence in the present, and His guidance for the future of our church. 3 pm: Dedication of new beautiful monument listing all the active churches in the denomination!

There is a sign-up sheet in the hallway. If enough people want to attend on Tuesday, June 15, we will take the church van or rent a larger bus for the day. Deadline to sign-up is May 30, so we can get the lunches ordered and make final plans for the trip. We will leave the church at 7:30 am on the 15th and return between 5:30 and 6 pm.
