## General Assembly Highlights

Rev. Boyce Wallace (former missionary) was elected as Moderator of General Assembly. Rev. Harry Chapman, Westside CP Church in Rio Rancho, New Mexico, was elected Vice-Moderator.

Rev. Michael Sharpe was elected to the office of Stated Clerk, following Rev. Robert Rush, who is retiring as of 30 September of this year.

The meetings took place at Dickson Middle School. There, the hallways were lined with displays from the agencies of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church.

Around 1,000 Cumberland Presbyterians celebrated the Bicentennial on Tuesday at the Birthplace Shrine in Montgomery Bell State Park. The day began with the Gathering of Stones, reflecting the theme of the 180<sup>th</sup> Assembly. Rev. C. William Jones was worship leader. The Spiritual Singers from Huntsville, Alabama provided special music. Dr. Jay Earheart-Brown, President of Memphis Theological Seminary delivered the sermon. In a nod to our Scottish ancestry Dennis Keifer playing the bag-pipe closed the service with "Amazing Grace". Displays from 1810 period included quilting, chocheting, tools, and games for the children. At 3 pm, Rev. Geoffrey Knight and his band of Cumberland musicians dedicated the new stones inscribed with the names of all Cumberland Presbyterian Churches.

At Women's Ministry Convention, which took place at the Montgomery Bell State Park Lodge, Glynda Corbin was elected secretary of Convention.
