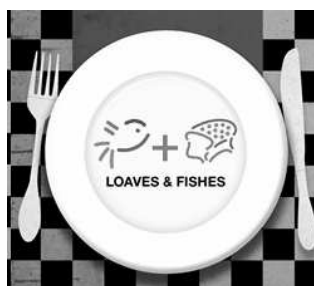

and Fishes project will provide the necessary funding specifically for supporting hot lunch programs in both the Andes and Cauca Valley presbyteries in Colombia as well as Juarez, Mexico.

50% of the total offering is used for a hunger project outside the US; 25% of the total offering is used for the Missions Team denominational Hunger Fund and sent to the Missions Ministry Team; 25% of the total offering is retained by the congregation to meet community hunger needs.
